

Board Meeting Highlights:

Much of the meeting was taken up with plans and arrangements for our important event, the Presidents' Day ceremony and luncheon.

Special Events were also discussed at some length. These outside events are a good source of revenue but some felt there are too many of them and it is hard to find enough volunteers. It was suggested that they be capped at two per month. No final decision were made and it was pointed out that there are always more in summer time so perhaps in the fall there will be fewer events.

Since we have lost Sharron and Jeff Adams as the prime movers for our monthly Saturday Open events, and also there seem to be fewer potential bowlers showing up for these, it was decided to have the Saturday Opens once a quarter instead of every month.

Chris Trenschel announced that we applied for a grant from Bowls USA and received \$600 which will be used for various equipment repairs and also help for the very successful evening leagues.

Eileen Morton agreed to coordinate bowling lessons until someone is found to take the job over. Anyone wishing lessons can reach me via phone or email which are in the 2019 Directory.

Reminders:

Leads – please remember, when raking the bowls after an end, the group of bowls needs to be placed <u>behind</u> the jack by about two feet and to the right side. This is important because sometimes a person is watching the course of his bowl and may step off the mat to the right side. I have seen this happen so please, bowls behind the jack out of the way.

People who lock up after the game or open in the morning – check the combination lock and make sure it is not <u>showing</u> our combination or something only one digit off. After you open the lock, please spin it to hide the combination. We have had some problems with security in the past.
